STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let cool.

Remove the cage from the back plate of the Mach 2 by removing the five

STEP 3 Remove the mesh screen from the cage.

STEP 2

Flip the Mach 2 cage over (PIC 2) and remove the 5 small screws. Be careful not to lose any hardware during this step, the screws are very small. Set these aside for use if you change back to the original style.

NOTE: Depending on the original configuration, the center star section and five Spikes (PIC 3) or emblem holder (PIC 4)can now be removed.

socket head cap screws. PIC 1 Set these aside, they will be reused.


As shown in PIC 5, place the Co-Ax insert in place on the front side of the cage. Insert one of the included #6-32 flat socket cap screws through one of the holes in the back of the cage, through the hole in the Insert and secure with one of the included socket nuts. Repeat for the other four holes. Tighten all five fasteners securely.


STEP 6 Install the screen mesh inside the Mach 2 cage and hold in place over the air filter installed on the backing plate.


STEP 7 Secure using the chrome $1/4''-20 \times 3/4''$ socket head cap screws removed in Step 2. Tighten securely.




